Dear Senator Hutchison:

Thank you for your inquiry of January 25, 2006, on behalf of Mr. Carl Fors, President of Speed Measurement Laboratories, Inc., Forth Worth, Texas, regarding his concerns about unauthorized radio frequency (RF) devices.

The Enforcement Bureau initiated investigations into the marketing of radar jammers in response to a complaint previously filed by Mr. Fors. The marketing and use of RF devices designed to intentionally jam or interfere with licensed radio services or other RF devices is prohibited. 47 U.S.C. § 302(b) and § 333. In addition, the Commission has specifically ruled that devices that are designed to jam or interfere with police radar may not be lawfully marketed in the U.S. *Rocky Mountain Radar*, 12 FCC Rcd. 22453 (1997).

Since our investigations are still pending, it would be inappropriate to provide further comment. Please be assured that we will carefully review each case consistent with the Commission's rules and policies.
