I am aware of the concerns that the Honorable Senator Kay Hutchison has brought to your attention regarding the sales of radar scramblers and jammers manufactured by Rocky Mountain Radar as 47 U.S.C. ss 302(b) and 333 prohibit the marketing and sale of RF devices designed to intentionally jam or interfere with licensed radio services or other RF devices.

I am also aware that the Spectrum Enforcement Division has contacted on line retailers that market these devices, demanding sales and purchasing records over the past year.

Therefore I am notifying your office and Senator Hutchison of a new retailer that is selling these prohibited devices both in their retail stores and their online website, Radio Shack.
